# ABDPH President's Message

Hope this finds you all well and enjoying your summer! The Board met this past April at the National Oral Health Conference (NOHC), where we conducted business meetings and administered the ABDPH specialty examination. This issue of the Newsletter provides information on these issues.

Christopher Okunseri, BDS, MSc, MLS, DDPHIRCSE, FFDRCSI was selected as the 2015-2016 Director-elect. Dr. Okunseri is Professor, Clinical Services at Marquette University School of Dentistry and began his director-elect duties in April at the NOHC in Kansas City, MO. Dr. Okunseri recently completed a three-year appointment as treasurer of the American Association of Public Health Dentistry.

The annual Diplomates' dinner was held at the NOHC and those in attendance celebrated the  $65^{th}$  anniversary of the specialty. Reg Louie, Linda Niessen, Caswell Evans reflected on the history of the specialty and our collective accomplishments. Fifteen of the Board's past presidents were in attendance. There were 8 new Diplomates inducted into the specialty.

This year the Board of Directors examined 10 applicants for the full examination; 27 candidates took the written only. This was a record number of candidates taking the written only and we look forward to those individuals challenging the rest of the examination in the years to come. Of the 10 full examination candidates, all but 1 had completed the written examination in a previous year. This year, the Board will conduct the full-examination for up to 12 candidates. The application deadline for the full examination is September 1, 2015

The Board continues to partner with AAPHD and others community of interests to review our 15-year-old dental public health competencies. A survey was sent to all Diplomates asking for their thoughts about the current competencies as well as of any new competencies that the specialty should consider. (Continued Page 2.)

In April, Diplomate Rebecca S King, DDS, MPH, was diagnosed with diffuse large B-cell lymphoma (non-Hodgkins). She is seeing a lymphoma specialist at UNC and undergoing chemotherapy. Dr. King has had three out of a series of six infusions, 21 days apart. It is a pretty aggressive disease, but the oncologist assures her that it is treatable and that the aggressive ones respond the best to chemo. She was a bit anxious about going through chemo, but feels that she is responding well. Her main side effects are nausea and fatigue, which tend to be more pronounced with the progressive treatments. There are very good medications for nausea and naps help with the fatigue. So far, her white cell count has rebounded nicely between treatments. Rebecca is optimistic that she will beat this and is looking forward to a cure.
